



OUR GOAL

The **Cross View 4.0 – Building for Generations** campaign goal is \$4.0 million over the next three years. If we exceed this goal, we can also add in components currently deferred due to budget constraints. We need your help to turn these dreams into reality!

WE HAVE A HEADSTART!

WE CAN ACHIEVE THIS TOGETHER!

A benchmark to consider for a 3-year pledge is 3X your current annual giving. In other words, if everyone were to maintain their normal church giving, plus give an equal amount towards the building project for each of the next three years, we would reach our goal!

CHRISTIAN FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

For some, the 3X benchmark is about right. For some, it might be too much at this time. For others, much more might be possible! Please consider these aspects of Christian financial stewardship, and then pray about how you can support the project:

• Firstfruits Giving

“Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops.” Proverbs 3:9

- God put us first when He gave His son; He gave us His very best. Does your pledge put God first?

• Proportionate Giving

“Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you.” Deuteronomy 16:17

- Does your pledge fully reflect the richness of God’s blessings on you?

• Sacrificial Giving

“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy...But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven...For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” Matthew 6:19-21

Frequently Asked Questions

Are the designs presented in the brochure the final plans?

They are a close approximation, but they are not finalized. Some minor refinements are expected. Also, if the campaign falls short of expectations, the scope will need to be reduced.

What if more money is pledged than the current goal?

First, we will praise God for the generous hearts of His people here at Cross View! There is a specific list of items that could be added into the scope if the funds are available. These items were originally envisioned, but then removed from the scope for financial reasons. We would be delighted to add them back.

What is the timeline for the campaign and the subsequent building project?

April – June 2018:
Capital Campaign

June – October 2018:
Final plans, permits and loan preparation

October 2018:
Voters' Assembly Meeting to approve loan

Spring 2019:
Begin construction

Christmas 2019:
Complete construction and building dedication

Could we take out a loan for more than \$2 million?

According to our treasurer's financial analysis and benchmarking discussions with lenders, the Church Council feels that it is prudent to limit the mortgage to approximately \$2 million.

What is the advantage of accelerating my payments?

A bridge loan will finance the construction prior to the complete fulfillment of the three-year pledges. Any portion of your pledge that is received by September 1, 2018 will reduce the principal amount of the construction bridge loan, which in turn reduces our borrowing cost.

How will my early pledge be secured until needed for construction?

Pledges will be maintained in a Cross View interest-bearing account that is designated for the campaign.

What is Commitment Sunday all about?

Commitment Sunday is a special, single communion service for our entire Cross View family to celebrate the gifts we pledge to expand Cross View for even greater service to our Lord and His Great Commission. Members will all submit their **Cross View 4.0 – Building for Generations** pledge card during the service. If you are unable to attend June 3rd, please submit your pledge card to the church office.
