BUILDING FOR GENERATIONS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: **Sanctuary**-The wood installation on the ceiling is wrapping up. Once complete, work will begin on installing lighting, speakers, audio and video projection equipment. We do not have a firm date for when we will be back in the sanctuary; **ECC**-east bathroom is scheduled to be complete in early January; **New Construction**-Elevator installation is scheduled to be complete in early January, drywall in the upper area and the main stairway is complete, taping continues. **Narthex**-All asbestos abatement is complete! The Emergency Exit door has moved from just west of the church office to just west of the kitchen. You can still walk through this "Emergency Exit" door to visit the church office.
