ANNOUNCEMENTS

BUILDING FOR GENERATIONS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Is on track to be completed by the end of February! Here is a recap of some of the recent activity:

Sanctuary: We anticipate that the wood ceiling will be done this week. Labor issues continue to delay this portion of the project. Work will start on rehangng light fixtures and speakers as soon as possible. After that, the sanctuary will be cleaned, and work will begin on refurbishing the organ and reinstalling pews. We expect to return to the sanctuary around mid-February.

Upper area: The main level bathrooms are complete. Painting continues and the multi-purpose tech room is framed in. Also, the kitchen floor and ceiling grid are installed. The narthex area is being cleared for ceiling tile and carpet installation.

Lower area: Crews completed bathroom tiling and a second coat of paint. The exterior and interior doors are being hung, and the upper and lower vestibule installations are complete.
