BUILDING FOR GENERATIONS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: Our building project is on track to be completed by the end of February! Here is a recap of some of the recent activity:

Sanctuary: The wood ceiling installation was extended another week. Workers are finishing the area above the altar and the trim work. Electricians are hanging new light fixtures, and sound technicians are repositioning and rehanging speakers. After that, the sanctuary will be cleaned and work will begin on refurbishing the organ. Pew installation is scheduled for the week of February 17th. Our sanctuary worship timeline has been moved to the end of February.

Upper area: The kitchen floor and ceiling grid are installed. Kitchen equipment is scheduled for installation Feb. 10. Café Cross View casework and narthex tile flooring is finished. Wood laminate wall covering is being installed in the multi-purpose room. Jonathan's new office (previously the west part of the Fireside Room) is ready for occupancy.

Lower area: Painting, bathroom tiling, and casework installation is done. Carpet installation is scheduled for next week. Installation of phone and data lines continues throughout the new construction. New photos are added weekly to the Building for Generations website.
