Cross View 4.0 – Building for Generations Construction Update

We are in the final stages of our construction project. All the "big ticket" items are complete and finishing work is in progress. Here is an update of recent activity:

Sanctuary: The pews returned with minimal damage. Praise break! Work has begun refurbishing the organ. Next steps include re-installing audio and video equipment. We expect to be back in the sanctuary by early March. A reminder that our Ash Wednesday and Sunday, March 1 services will be in the new multi-purpose room, which will be called the Great Commission Room.

Upper area: Carpet and tile installation is complete. Electronics are being transitioned to the new technology control room. Multi-media connections will extend to the Sanctuary, Great Commission Room, all classrooms and fellowship areas. We will use temporary technology for initial Great Commission Room services.

Other updates: Multiple inspections started Wednesday and will conclude with a "Temporary Occupancy Certificate" Tuesday, February 25th. Furniture for the new spaces will be installed February 24th and 25th. New photos are added weekly to the
