Last week they served over 605 families with pantry boxes and thousands of pounds of fresh produce, laundry soap, and toilet paper. There are openings for the distribution line from 10:30-12:30, and for the pack and prep team from 12:30-2:30 (all food not used is packed and loaded into trucks for distribution at other locations).
