There continues to be great progress on our building project. The renovations to the ECC classrooms will be complete and ready for use after Labor Day. The Building Steering team is finalizing the plan for the Sanctuary ceiling and the fire sprinkler installation will be completed by Aug. 30. Progress also continues on the new addition, with the pre-cast walls in place. Work on the addition in September includes the placement of the multi-purpose room concrete floor and steel roof rafters.
