4.0 BUILDING FOR GENERATIONS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- October is a critical month to finish the outside work before the ground freezes. Projects to be completed include enclosing the multi-purpose room, connecting the multi-purpose room to the existing building, and finishing the landscape work. Pray for a dry and warm October!
- The sanctuary fire sprinkler installation is complete. Progress has also been made on wiring the sanctuary for LED lighting. The next step will be hanging the ceiling sheetrock, followed by the installation of the cedar tongue and groove ceiling. If all goes according to schedule, worship services will be back in the sanctuary by mid-November.
