CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL: Today's Topic: The Israelites Cross the Red Sea in Exodus 13:17-14:31. Bible verse to memorize: Psalm 23:1. Bible point: God helps us when we're afraid. What to talk about at home: Talk about a time when you were afraid and share how God helped you.
