CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL: Today's Topic: God forgives David in 2 Samuel 12:1-7; Psalm 51:1-12. Bible verse to memorize: 1 John 1:9. Bible point: God wants us to repent when we sin. What to talk about at home: Share something that you need to confess to God and pray together about it.

SR. YOUTH SUNDAY SCHOOL: Today's lesson examines three key truths found in the life of Joshua: Leadership can be learned, leadership benefits everyone, and leadership produces change. These key principles form the foundation for moving forward in leadership, and they help teenagers counter the myths of leadership discussed in the previous lesson.

JR. YOUTH SUNDAY SCHOOL: Today we start a 5 week Right Now Media series on The Bible, exploring Scripture as a whole grand story that showcases who God is.
