JUNE 14 CROSS VIEW WORSHIP RE-OPENS! Cross View's Church Council met on Tuesday, June 2nd, and has decided to re-open for onsite worship beginning on Sunday, June 14th.

We look forward to seeing everyone in person; however, while we continue to be under the threat of COVID-19, please understand that worship will look different. If you did not receive an email regarding the details, please let the church office know. Some of the most important items to consider are:

- **You must PRE-REGISTER to attend either the 8 am Traditional worship, or the 11 am Contemporary worship:** State law limits us to approximately 90 people per room, so we will have limited seating available. We will be using Event-Brite to reserve worship seats in advance.
- **People who are high risk should stay home, and those over the age of 65 should consider staying home:** As Christians, we love our neighbor and want them to stay well. The online stream will be available for those at home.
- **Masks are required for everyone over the age of two:** This follows health guidelines. We ask everyone to bring their own mask, but we'll have some available if you forget.
- **There will be no onsite classes, fellowship opportunities, or nursery care:** At this time, we will not be holding any fellowship opportunities inside the building.

FINANCIAL UPDATE – YEAR-TO-DATE RESULTS

- April year-to-date income was 7%, or \$34K less than budget year-to-date.
- Expenses continue to be managed tightly, especially at this time when the building is closed to worship and programs. As a result, expenses were also less than budget, resulting in a year-to-date surplus of \$48K. The surplus does not include expected CARES Act Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan forgiveness of \$68K for Cross View as of April 30.
- The ECC is operating with reduced students and associated tuition, resulting in a year-to-date deficit of \$7K. Expected PPP loan forgiveness totals \$77K for the ECC as of April 30.
- The PPP loan continues to be used as required in order to be forgiven. The loan allowed us to maintain full payroll. Without the loan staff reductions would have occurred. We are grateful for the donations received from our members and guests, but future giving to Cross View and tuition for our Early Childhood Center remains very uncertain. God has been good to Cross View for 50 years. We continue to put our trust in Him to guide us through all things.
- Church Council is happy to report that our independent financial auditor has reviewed 2019 Cross View and ECC financial results and issued a positive report with no discrepancies. There are no material changes to our 2019 reported financial results. Thanks to our amazing financial and administrative staff and to our Church Council Treasurer, Linda Baule.
