



The “Restored!” logo is a bold proclamation of Cross View’s commitment to restore our entire facility to proper condition to better serve as an equipping station for ministry. Pieces of the letters are missing or misplaced, but as the eye moves to the top of the “T” (which also serves as a central cross), the letters are restored. Some of the corners in the logo have shifted from squared to rounded, symbolizing the inherent change in restoration. Finally, the subtle small circles (or nail holes) in the cross remind us of the ultimate restoration: our broken relationship with God being restored by the death and resurrection of Christ.
